Monday 26th March

Melbourne Laneway Tours

Tuesday 27 March

Yarra Valley Winery Tour

Departing Crown Promenade at 9:00am and travelling to the Yarra Valley by luxury coach, the first stop is picturesque Domain Chandon, the Australian production house for Moet & Chandon. Upon arrival, you will join a guided tour through the winery, followed by a relaxing glass of Australia's best bubbly along with light nibbles.

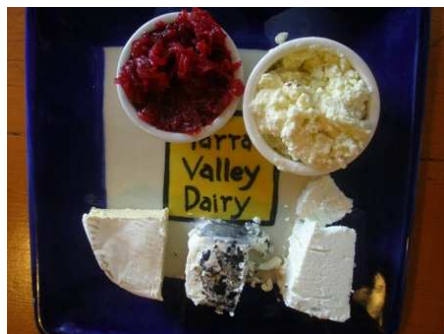
From Domain Chandon, it is on to Zonzo's at Train Trak for a 2 course Italian style lunch. Embracing a traditional Italian method of sharing, the food is placed on a long table allowing for all to casually indulge and savour a variety of dishes. Boasting one of the best views in the valley, Zonzo is situated at the Train Trak vineyard set amongst forty- five acres of vines.

After lunch, it is off to Punt Road Wines, located in the heart of the Yarra Valley. This cellar door provides a warm and friendly environment for a complete and relaxing wine tasting experience.

Our final stop for the day is Yarra Valley Dairy to sample some of the locally produced cheeses that are made in an Italian / French manner. The Cheese Shop is located in a 100 year old milking shed with beautiful views of the Yarra Valley.

The tour concludes upon arrival back at Crown Promenade which will be around 4.30-5.00pm.

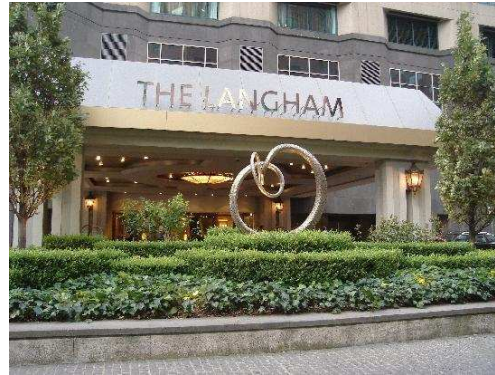
