CREDIT CARD

The quickest and simplest way to pay your membership fees is by logging onto the Members Area of the IBD website: <http://www.ibd.org.uk/>. Subscription rates are payable in GB pounds and the rate of exchange will be determined by the daily rate applicable at the time of payment. **There is no 5% surcharge for payments made by this method.**
