No application can be placed before the Council unless it is accompanied by the relevant subscription. The 2009 year subscription is \$AUD235.00 which includes \$0.00 GST. Current members of the MBAA pay a reduced 2009 subscription of \$210.00.

This subscription is reduced to \$AUD165.00 (includes \$0.00 GST) for members joining after 30 June 2009 and remains at this rate until 31 October 2009; thereafter 2010 subscription rates apply. As all the subscription monies collected is remitted to London, no GST applies.
